Tournament Rules

1. The 2018 TBAV Challenge Series (comprising four separate events, along with the 2018 State Championships Combined All Events results and an athlete's final qualifying position in the WynCity Open) is open to all 2018 TBA Registered Players, residing in Victoria (including Albury). All bowlers will be required to present their 2018 TBA Registered Player Card, or receipt of payment, at the check-in of their first event.
2. Tenpin Bowling Australia Limited rules and regulations shall apply at all times, including but not limited to the Code of Conduct, the Social Media and the Member Protection Policies.
3. All females and juniors (junior aged as at 31 December 2018) will receive 8 pins bonus per game (including finals). For the purposes of the Challenge Series only, all females and juniors will have the 8 pins retrospectively applied to their respective 2018 State Championship Combined All Events result and the WynCity Open (as per the rules of that event)
4. If a female or junior wins an event, they will forgo their 8 bonus pins per game for the remaining 2018 tournaments (excludes 2018 State Championships Combined All Events and the WynCity Open).
5. All bowlers are required to wear a collared shirt or a bowling industry shirt. Males may wear slacks or dress shorts; females may wear a skirt, slacks or dress shorts. The Tournament Director will determine what constitutes acceptable attire.
6. No bowler will be permitted to smoke or consume alcohol during the tournament.
7. Mobile phones must be switched off whilst bowling; personal entertainment systems (mp3, iPods, iPads, etc), along with the use of 'apps' will not be permitted in the players' area.
8. The designated players' area will be for participating bowlers only. The designated players' area shall be confirmed during the briefing session for each event
9. Tournament director reserves the right to check any bowling equipment.
10. All ties will be subject to a 10th frame roll off until the tie is broken. Where roll-off frames are required to break a tie, no further bonus pins shall be awarded to females or juniors in that element of play.
11. Series event points will be allocated as per TBAV rankings system. Bowlers finishing outside the finalists, will have ranking points allocated based on their finishing position (total pinfall including bonus pins). Finalists will receive points as per their total pinfall placing (including bonus pins) at the end of their respective final round.
12. The end of year rankings will be based on the individuals 4 highest placings (including the bowler's 2018 State Championships Combined All Events result or an athlete's final qualifying position in the WynCity Open). In the event of a tie, it will not be broken and all relevant prize money will be split.
13. Any matters not covered in the conditions above will be referred to the tournament director, whose decision will be final.
14. Event entries close at 5:00pm on the Friday before the event however, late entries may be accepted subject to lane availability. The entry fee for event numbers 3 to 6 will be \$100 per bowler per event.
15. All bowlers participating in the 2018 TBAV Challenge Series will be required to provide personal contact details.

Format

Qualifying

All bowlers will bowl 6 games, changing lanes after each 2 game block, to cut to the top 50% of the field based on total pinfall (including bonus pins).

Finals Round 1 (top 50% of the field based on total pinfall – including bonus pins)

Bowlers will bowl a further 2 games, with pinfall (including bonus pins) carried over from Qualifying to determine the top 10 (based on cumulative pinfall – including bonus pins)

Finals Round 2

The top 10 bowlers will bowl an additional one game, with pinfall (including bonus pins) carried over from Qualifying and Round 1 Finals – to determine the top 5 for the Step ladder Matchplay

Step Ladder Matchplay (no pinfall carry-over)

Match 1 – bowlers finishing in positions 3, 4 and 5, from Finals Round 2, will bowl a single game. Based on total pinfall for this game (including bonus pins) – the winner advances to Match 2; the remaining bowlers will finish 4th and 5th respectively

Match 2 – the winner of Match 1 will bowl a single game against the bowler who finished in position 2 from Finals Round 2. Based on total pinfall for this game (including bonus pins) – the winner advances to Match 3; the remaining bowler will finish 3rd

Match 3 - the winner of Match 2 will bowl a single game against the bowler who finished in position 1 from Finals Round 2. Based on total pinfall for this game (including bonus pins) – the winner will be declared the event winner; and the remaining bowler will finish 2nd

Bonus Prizes:

For all non-cashing bowlers, there will be two opportunities to win \$50 by simply bowling a strike.
